

MY FELLOWSHIP AT GANGA HOSPITAL, COIMBATORE INDIA, 2025

DR ADERA TENAGNE AMBELU

My name is Dr Adera Tenagne Ambelu , consultant plastic and reconstructive surgeon from Bahir Dar, ETHIOPIA at Felegehiwot hospital. It is one of the oldest hospital in Ethiopia and act as referral center for Northwest of Ethiopia. It serves almost all of Amhara, benishangulgumuz region, parts of Oromia, especially Wollega area and southern Tigray which is about 80 million of population. I am a single consultant surgeon at the area with huge burden of cases of plastic and reconstructive surgery.

So far I have try to reconstruct cases using grafts, local flaps and regional and some distant flaps.

Microsurgery service is not available in my area. Even at country level there are only 2 trained micro surgeons with limited experience due to logistic limitations.

As a surgeon I have graduated more recently from COSECSA AND ADDIS ABABA University in 2024 and had only worked for 05 months before I got fellowship of microsurgery training in Ganga under BFIRST.

But my five years of stay as trainee and resident of plastic surgery I had a chance to rotate among different hospitals of Addis Ababa.

Microsurgery service is not something for advanced care; it is basic care for country like Ethiopia who is passing conflicts every decade and so populous.

I believe that the investment that BFIRST do on our training will have huge impact on the overall acre of patients in Ethiopia as well as AFRICA IN GENERAL.
